Our rent includes everything except a bath towel so you only pay one price per month, it also includes cleaning twice a month, grocery shopping rides, almost all our events, and personal attention when you need it. We are a small community of students from 27 different countries around the world, about 115 total in apartments. We promote a balanced lifestyle for all our students providing you with a safe, comfortable, central and positive environment for you to thrive and flourish.

### Rules and Regulations:

The Rules and Regulations are important for all students to understand and respect. Our goal is for everyone in our housing to be safe and comfortable, therefore, there are no candles or items of fire allowed on the property, smoking is outside only, respect for the property and management is important, no house parties and no hard drugs allowed.

We encourage students to take advantage of all the fun events in Santa Barbara, we host many events ourselves, and we promote our properties as a safe home to live peacefully and successfully. All of our properties are close by and students become a community of friends.

We provide personal assistance, grocery shopping trips, printer use for all students and often take interested students on Santa Barbara hikes, beach BBQ's, stand up paddle boarding, yoga & meditation and many other events.

# **ID Requirements**:

Requirements for international students are copies of your <u>passport</u>, <u>visa and I-20 documents</u>. Requirements for American students is a copy of a credit report and social security number. A Skype interview is required. Your payment of the application fee, deposit and first month's rent are due within two weeks of your confirmation to secure your housing. Bank wire details are included on the invoice if you would like to wire your payment or you can pay by credit card though our online source - Rentmoola.

### Lease Terms:

Our leases are 5.5 months minimum: July 15 - December 31 and January 1 - June 15. Students do not have to leave during holidays and welcome to leave their belongings in their rooms during their time away. If you are attending a school with different semester dates, please let us know and we can sometimes arrange an alternate time frame for the lease.

### Included:

Our rent includes everything except a bath towel so you only pay one price per month. The rent price includes everything: all utilities (water, trash, electric, gas), Wifi, cable tv, printer, all furniture, linens, kitchenware, dinnerware, cleaning twice a month, grocery shopping rides and assistance throughout stay as well as most Coral Group events. Normally students would need to pay for these items separately from rent, but we make sure to make it easy for Coral Group students in one rental price each month. There are no added fees.
